But Nanga is only eight years old; She's too young to be a water-woman. Everyone thinks so. Sometimes, Nanga envies his brother, Rai, who has no responsibility to save the village. Because the water in the well tastes more and more like salt: it's drying up, and only a N'Wone can find the solution.
